In 2006, he headed the 'Regulation Taskforce' for the Prime Minister and Treasurer, and in 2013 he was appointed to the Prime Minister's Business Advisory Council. In 2014 Gary was awarded the Economic Society of Australia's inaugural Distinguished Public Policy Fellow Award.
